

A ROADMAP FOR CHANGE IN THE NEW YEAR



efore you could pencil in your New Year's resolutions for 2019, the two largest US automakers had you beaten. General Motors recently announced its plans to halt production at 7 factories in North America by the end of 2019, putting about 18,000 salaried employees out of work. With the job cuts, production of 6 popular models will cease, including the Chevy Cruze, Chevy Impala, Chevy Volt, and Buick LaCrosse. This move is an effort to cut costs in the short term and increase cash flow in the long term.

Months before General Motors' announcement, Ford Motor Company declared it would cease production of its entire fleet of cars except the Mustang in light of a market shift toward crossovers, trucks, and SUV's.

Both automakers are responding to changes in consumer tastes and spending patterns, while also making an effort to stay at the forefront of emergent technologies in the industry. Understandably, the news has been hard for many employees to bear, but GM and Ford are ultimately acting in light of their objective: to remain in business and continue making a profit.
